Assesses the overall needs of the individual patients and allocates appropriate available resources and nursing staff, providing adequate supervision, support, and guidance where necessary.
- Proficient in preparing, monitoring, and caring for critically ill patients during emergent and nonemergent bedside procedures, including endotracheal intubation, tracheostomy, cricoideotomy, thoracentesis, paracentesis, chest tube insertion, lumbar puncture, central/arterial line insertion, cardioversion, incision and drainage, bronchoscopy, endoscopy/colonoscopy, blood transfusions, external pacing/transvenous pacemaker insertion, neurosurgical burr holes, drain placement and intracranial pressure monitoring, pulmonary artery catheter, urinary catheterization, enteral (OG/NG/G/J/PEG) tube placement, thrombolytic therapy.
- Key member of hospital-wide Rapid Response/Code Blue team, responding to internal emergencies in all areas of service to patients demonstrating signs of imminent clinical deterioration with the goal of preventing injury, respiratory arrest, cardiac arrest, or death.
